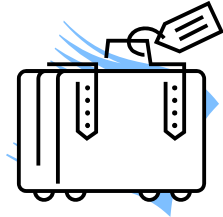

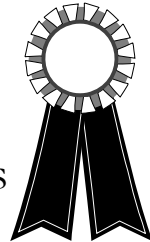

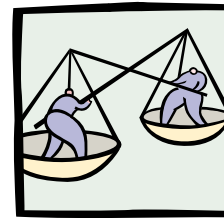
Top Quality Learning
