Cleves' Vision:

A review of our values:

Cleves' trustees and staff have a duty to ensure that pupils learn values that are relevant to the world around them today. Cleves' values had remained the same for some years and society's thinking moves on, so we felt a review was timely.

We have taken time over the review, since the values that we teach are a crucial part of a child's development academically, emotionally and socially. We looked at the values of other local schools and the values of a range of disparate organisations; then we shared with trustees, staff and pupil associate governors a long list of potential values and discussed the existing values and possible new ones. There was a surprising degree of consensus amongst staff, pupils and trustees about the short list we arrived at. School staff felt it was important that all children learned the same values, and that in some cases expectations of older children should be more sophisticated.
