Reading Comprehension Questions - Lower KS2

Retrieval	<ul> <li>What did?</li> <li>Who was?</li> <li>Where did?</li> <li>When did?</li> <li>How many/often?</li> <li>Identify 2 things you learn about</li> <li>Find 2 facts about in this paragraph.</li> </ul>
Inference	<ul> <li>Why does ?</li> <li>How did feel? How do you know?</li> <li>What would you do if you were ? Why?</li> <li>What words would you use to describe ? Why</li> </ul>
Prediction	<ul> <li>What do you think will happen next?</li> <li>Do you think will?</li> <li>What do you think will do? Why?</li> </ul>

Authorial intent	<ul> <li>Which words/phrases help the reader to imagine?</li> <li>What does the word suggest?</li> <li>Why is in inverted commas/bold/italics?</li> <li>How does the layout and presentation of this help you?</li> <li>Why has some of the information been presented as a table/in a box?</li> </ul>
Summarise	<ul> <li>What has happened so far?</li> <li>Can you tell me 3 things you have learnt so far?</li> <li>What is the important event that happens in this chapter?</li> <li>What is the main point of this paragraph?</li> </ul>
Compare	<ul> <li>What did you like about this book?</li> <li>What was the most exciting part of the story?</li> <li>What similarities and differences can you identify between and?</li> <li>How is this story similar to?</li> <li>How is this character similar to?</li> </ul>
