Compare	<ul> <li>What is your opinion of? Do you know any other characters who are similar?</li> <li>Have you read a story that begins/ends in the same way?</li> <li>What similarities and differences can you identify between the description of and?</li> <li>How is this story similar to?</li> <li>How is the theme of this book similar to?</li> <li>Do the author's other books have similar themes?</li> </ul>
