TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Children need to be dropped to school at **3pm** on **Sunday 14th June**. The children will be told their coach number in advance.

We will return to Cleves at approximately **2.30pm** on **Wednesday 17th June**. In the event of a substantial delay on our return journey, we will email updates.

ACCOMMODATION

We are all in the same building. The children will be staying in ensuite rooms, which are along main corridors next to clearly identified teacher/adult rooms. Children will be informed of their room allocations on arrival.

BISCUITS

We are asking for donations of biscuits for the trip. Please ensure these are **NUT** free. If your child has dietary requirements then please hand in appropriate biscuits in a named bag. Please hand them in to your class teacher.

MEDICATION

Medication Drop Off - Thursday 11th June - Year 6 Central Area - 3.30-4pm

Thank you for completing the Residential Medical Form. Staff will use these forms to check instructions and log any medication that needs to be administered during your child's stay at PGL Liddington. If your child requires any medication during their stay at PGL Liddington, this **MUST** be dropped off on **Thursday 11th June**.

Please note that we cannot accept any medication that is not in the original box as dispensed by the pharmacist. The instruction leaflet should also be provided. If your child has been prescribed new medication since completing the medical form please email the details to Mrs Pyott (ipyott@cleves.co.uk).

School held medication

If your child has any medication that is held at school - auto injector pens, inhaler etc, these will be taken on the trip.

Over the counter medicines

We will be taking a small supply of over the counter medicines - Calpol, Piriton and Anthisan. You do not need to provide this unless your child requires this daily.

Travel sickness tablets

We will require parental consent to administer travel sickness tablets for the residential, please ensure that this medication has been stated on the Residential Medical Form. Without the original box, blister pack with expiry date and parent consent we will not be able to administer this. Please ensure your child has taken the medication before they arrive on Sunday and include a tablet for the return journey.

CLOTHING

The following items are a guide to what you may want to pack. Children have to carry their own bags, so bear this in mind when packing. We have been allocated some water activities which will result in the children getting very dirty and wet, so extra sets of **old clothes** are recommended. Please make sure that everything is clearly labelled. Hair must be tied back for all activities.

All children must bring their own bedding, this can be a pillow and a sleeping bag or duvet. If possible please pack everything into one bag, if you can't then please make sure everything is labelled as multiple bags may get separated in the coach.

Trousers/leggings (for activities - no jeans)	Waterproof Coat (and trousers if you have them)	Large plastic bag for dirty clothes - labeled
Warm jumpers/sweatshirts/fleece	2 pairs of sturdy closed toed shoes	Water shoes (or shoes that can get wet)
T-Shirts (at least 1 with long sleeves)	1 pair of dry shoes for the evening	Sun cream and sun hat/cap
Underwear and socks (that cover ankles)	1 or 2 evening outfits	Wash kit - shampoo, soap, toothbrush and toothpaste. NO aerosol deodorants
Pyjamas/Nightwear	Gloves (for climbing)	Two towels (bath and hand)
Refillable <u>named</u> water bottle and a spare if possible	Slippers/flip flops	Shorts
Pillow	Duvet/Sleeping bag	Small day bag

NO mobile phones, air tags, radios, smart watches, electronic games, jewellery, make up, hair straighteners etc.

NO cameras; that includes **NO** disposable cameras. **NO** Aerosols.

Please do not send any money with your child as there will not be an opportunity to spend any.

Please do not pack any sweets, snacks or food in your child's luggage. We have many children with severe allergies, so it's imperative that they aren't exposed to any allergens.
